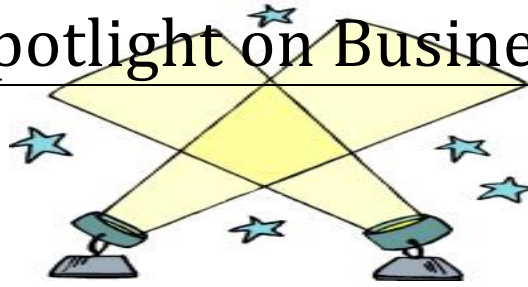


Spotlight on Business
