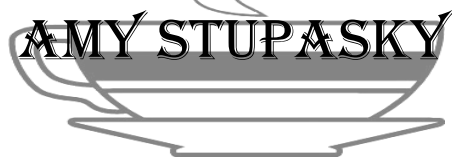


## QUINCYAN OF THE WEEK!
